Arriving in theaters on October 21 is the highly-anticipated action flick, **Doom**, based on id Software's wildly popular videogame series of the same name.

GIVE THE DVD PLAYER A BREAK!

Yes, it's true. The lazy days of summer are winding down and it's time to start thinking about hitting the books, long hours spent in the classroom, boring papers, and videogame withdrawal. If there's a bright spot in all of this, it's that the theaters are still packed with summer films! Two films that we're particularly looking forward to are "Doom" and "Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire." When you're ready to put down the remote and venture outside the house, other films that could very well be worth your time and money include:

The Doom movie stars Karl Urban, best known for his portrayal of Eomer in the Lord of the Rings films; professional wrestler-turned-action movie sensation Dwayne "The Rock" Johnson (Be Cool, The Rundown); and former Bond bad girl Rosamund Pike (Die Another Day).

Urban recently told IGN.com, "To a certain extent nothing prepares you for Doom. Four months of dark corridors and med labs and blood and firing weapons. That was just day in and day out... loading, unloading thousands of rounds." Sounds cool to us!

The movie follows John Grimm (Urban), a Marine who is nicknamed "Reaper" (as in grim reaper) by the other members of his squad. Heading up the squad is Sarge, played by The Rock. As with the game, they're stationed at a Martian research facility owned and operated by the UAC – the Union Aerospace Corporation.

The UAC facility is researching and developing teleportation devices. Among the scientists working there is John's estranged sister, Samantha (Pike). Needless to say, strange things are happening at the facility. Inhabitants are dead or missing, frayed lab coats and severed limbs are discovered, and there seems to be little explanation as to why. If you're at all familiar with the games, then you already know that the facility's experiments have somehow unleashed monstrous, infernal beings and now it's up to John to save the day.

Doom devotees shouldn't expect the movie's monsters to be cheesy computer-generated imagery – this is a top-shelf affair. Legendary effects guru Stan Winston and his creative team, who specialize in animatronics and makeup effects, will be bringing the creatures to life. You might recognize their work from the Jurassic Park films, the Terminator movies, and the Alien and Predator franchises.



Harry Potter AND THE GOBLET OF FIRE

“Dark and difficult times lie ahead, Harry,” warns Albus Dumbledore (Michael Gambon), in **HARRY POTTER AND THE GOBLET OF FIRE**. And as everyone’s favorite pubescent wizard confronts the formidable challenges of teenage life, he also finds himself at the center of terrifying events that will affect the whole wizarding world.

The fourth film in the blockbuster Harry Potter fantasy franchise has Harry Potter (Daniel Radcliffe) facing his greatest challenge yet when he’s mysteriously picked to compete in the prestigious Triwizard Tournament, a thrilling international competition that pits him against older and more experienced students from Hogwarts and two rival wizarding schools in Europe. Meanwhile, supporters of the evil Lord Voldemort (Ralph Fiennes), send a shockwave of fear throughout the wizard community when their Dark Mark scorches the sky at the Quiditch World Cup, signaling Voldemort’s return to power. But for Harry, this isn’t the only news causing him anxiety – he still has to find a date for the Yule Ball.

Mike Newell (Mona Lisa Smile, Four Weddings and a Funeral, Donnie Brasco) is directing Goblet of Fire from a script adapted from J.K. Rowling’s novel by Steve Kloves. Rupert Grint and Emma Watson have, of course, returned to their roles as Harry’s best friends, Ron Weasley and Hermione Granger. And many supporting cast members from previous Potter flicks will also be reprising their parts,


including Robbie Coltrane as Rubeus Hagrid, Alan Rickman as Severus Snape, and Michael Gambon as Albus Dumbledore.

New additions to the cast this time around include Ralph Fiennes (The English Patient, Schlinder’s List) as Lord Voldemort (a.k.a. He-Who-Must-Not-Be-Named), Miranda Richardson (Sleepy Hollow, The Hours) as snooping Daily Prophet reporter Rita Skeeter, Robert Pattinson (The Ring) as Triwizard competitor Cedric Diggory, Clemence Poesy (Bienvenue chez les Rozes, Petite Soeur) as the lovely Fleur Delacour, and Stanislav Ianevski as Quidditch star Viktor Krum. Katie Leung plays Harry’s crush, Cho Chang. And Brendan Gleeson (Troy, Cold Mountain) also stars as the new Defense Against the Dark Arts teacher, Mad-Eye Moody.

Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire opens simultaneously in standard-format and IMAX theaters on November 18th. For the latest news on the flick visit IGN FilmForce (<http://filmforce.ign.com>).

An interview with Family Guy's Alex Borstein

To fans of the animated hit Family Guy, Alex Borstein is best known as the voice of the wife with a wild streak (and object of baby Stewie's matricidal desires), Lois Griffin. In addition to voicing nearly a dozen other roles (including Loretta Brown, Barbara Pewterschmidt, and Asian Reporter Tricia Takanawa), she's also been a writer on the series since its third season. Borstein was also a long-running castmember on Fox's MadTV, creating many memorable characters (who can forget the unique logic of Ms. Swan?) in her 5 years on the show.

After being cancelled by Fox at the end of its third season, Family Guy found a brand new audience as a part of Cartoon Network's [adult swim] block. And, spurred on by massive sales of the first three seasons on DVD, Fox greenlit a direct-to-DVD movie and eventually the series' return to prime time with a brand-new fourth season.

That original direct-to-DVD movie, Stewie Griffin: The Untold Story!, will be available September 27th, 2005 from Fox Home Entertainment.



IGN: It's my understanding that, based on the success of the Family Guy reruns on [adult swim], Fox initially approached Seth (MacFarlane, creator of Family Guy) to do just the direct-to-DVD movie. What was your initial reaction to that door opening?

ALEX BORSTEIN: Well, the way I was brought into the loop, was that I found out through Seth that things were kind of a-stir... a-brew? I don't know what you'd say... and he called me up at home and just said, "You know, there's rumblings that this thing might actually come back..." And I was like, "Fudge you!" I said, "Come on... You know what, Seth? Don't mess with me. Don't tell me something like that unless it's real. Call me when it looks like it's actually gonna happen." And, I don't know, a few weeks later, my phone rang, and he was like, "Well, it's actually gonna happen." And I flipped out. To answer your question, I'm not sure if they called him initially about the DVD. That sounds familiar... I think they were hearing something like that...

IGN: How would you describe the plot of the movie?

BORSTEIN: It's interesting... Do you know how it came to be? It's made up of three episodes that will also be airing separately as well. We knew that was going to be the case, so we broke the stories to fit – and it was actually quite a task. It was one of the hardest things that any of us had ever done as writers. It was really difficult. But we knew we wanted it to be an adventure, and we knew we wanted to take him on the road, so that's what we did. We said, "Okay, Stewie... You're going to be getting in a Winnebago with a pervert named Quagmire."


IGN: But so many movies have used that plot!

BORSTEIN: Exactly! A baby and a pervert... together.

IGN: Being direct-to-video, you're freed from the restraints of standards & practices and network TV. How much raunchier/adult should people expect the movie to be?

BORSTEIN: It's pretty filthy! I have to admit, it's filthy. I'm going to probably have to warn my mother before she sees it. I don't know... I feel as long as it's done in the spirit of comedy and entertainment, I'm all for it. I have no point in my system or morals where I say, "This is too far."

IGN: How has Lois evolved as a character since you started the role, and how do you view her evolution?

BORSTEIN: She really has, and it's been really cool. When I first came on the show, I was just doing voices, and I met Seth through doing MadTV. One of the same people in development who developed MadTV was also developing with Seth, and introduced us. When I first started doing the voice, I had nothing to do with the show as a writer, and I kind of brought this voice to it and he liked it. As I started doing things in the booth, I would sometimes adlib a little, or add something here or there, and he liked it, and the writers enjoyed it. One of the writers in particular, who's now one of our executive producers – his name is Chris Sheridan – he was like, "You know, you should write for this show. You'd be great, and we really could use a female voice in the room. It would be really great, and you should consider it." And I was like, "I would love to!" So I started kind of moonlighting on days that I wasn't working at MadTV, and doing some consulting and part-time, and when the season ended at MadTV, I went to Family Guy full time.

IGN: Do you have any plans for another one-woman show? (you can find out more about Alex's show, Alex Borstein: Drop Dead Gorgeous in a Down-To-Earth Bombshell Sort of Way," at her official website, www.alexborstein.com)

BORSTEIN: Well, we are currently editing my show and are going to be releasing it on DVD. I kind of want to play with this whole power-to-the-people thing, like with NetFlix, and kind of self-distribute and see what I can do. I've been working on my website and it's been a huge hit – particularly the Family Guy fans have just been losing their minds on it, so we want to be able to offer something. So we want to try doing this self-distribution online.

IGN: Why do you think Family Guy continues to strike a chord with viewers?

BORSTEIN: I think part of it is that Family Guy came back at kind of a backlash time, with our current president, current state of the nation and where we are, 9/11, Janet Jackson and boobies malfunctions... It really came back at a time when I think people were like, "Oh my god, this is too much..." and they needed to laugh and just let go, and I think Family Guy really afforded people to do that. I also think our success is our fans. It's unbelievable. They're so loyal, and they're so up for anything. I mean, they will tune in and turn on and run out and buy this and look at that and read this... If an article's in a magazine, they buy it. They're speaking with their dollars, and they're so strong that we owe every single moment of our employment right now to our fans, and we know it.

An interview with Futurama star Billy West

Mel Blanc was known as "The Man of 1,000 Voices", but give Billy West a few more years and he might give the legend a run for his money.

As Stimpfy on the original Ren & Stimpy (and later Ren as well), Bugs Bunny & Elmer Fudd in Space Jam (reprising Fudd for Back in Action), and a host of characters on Futurama (Fry, Dr. Zoidberg, Professor Farnsworth, and Zapp Brannigan – to name a few), West is the very definition of a voice artist, able to manipulate his vocal chords like a maestro (how's that for an image?). He's also working on an edgy semi-autobiographical pilot titled Billy Bastard: Amateur Human Being (you can find out more on his website, www.billywest.com)

IGN: How would you sum up your experience on Futurama?

WEST: I thought the whole experience – from top to bottom – was totally professional and really cool. I never had anybody bugging me for anything, no directors standing on my throat while they are directing me. That was the kind of abuse that came with Ren & Stimpy...many actors were simply beaten down. People were emotional wrecks to the point where they had to come in with tow trucks and pick up bodies to get them out of there. That's what I was told by Nickelodeon. They were saying, "You've gotta watch out, this guy wears actors out." My response to that was, "Bring it On! I have had the worst things that can happen to a human being happen to me in the first 10 years of my life, so I was tailored made for abuse." But I did not know how long I would last with all the screaming and yelling, and it was not just the screaming and yelling, it was the particular screaming and yelling that was taking place.

IGN: And Futurama was the complete opposite of that?

WEST: Yeah, it was the total opposite of that. There's no need for torture. There really isn't. I mean, I like the idea that he was pushing me, to drive me to other places, but constant repetition of screaming... As I look back, I could have blown my voice out, for real. I couldn't talk after a few sessions. But I learned how to do it, and I discovered a new place in my throat where I could do it effortlessly and sound like I was on fire.

IGN: So, in some ways, it was a worthy learning experience...

WEST: Yeah... Everything's a learning experience, whether you're learning bad things or good ones.

IGN: If you were to look at the four Futurama episodes they chose to include on the Monster Robot Maniac Fun Collection ("Hell Is Other Robots," "Anthology of Interest I," Roswell That Ends Well," & "The Sting"), which would you say is your personal favorite?



WEST: Those are all great – I love every one of them. There's not an episode I don't like... I think some were better than others... but I do like "Roswell That Ends Well," because it has some great interaction with one of Fry's relatives from the 50's, who got married to a girl who eventually had Fry's father, or something like that. Very Back to the Future. I like that one the best. Time runs amok, and I love time travel and people that play with time. It's so cool.

IGN: And what about the rumors of new Futurama adventures on the horizon?

WEST: Well, they're more than rumors. I was talked to. The first bulletin that I got is that they were in talks with Fox because Fox was very, very happy with the way the DVDs were selling. (Executive Producer) David Cohen told me they were in talks with Fox and that things were looking great, and that their idea was to make a Futurama movie to DVD, and then maybe release a second one. Then I heard that it was decided to do that.

IGN: And you're ready and rarin' to go?

WEST: I'm ready and rarin' to go, because I love that show more than anything. I thought it was just far and away above anything I had ever done.
